Dear LANDOWNER:

Strada and NDACT would like to take this opportunity to thank you for registering to participate in the WELLness Check Program as part of Schedule C of the Community Engagement Agreement.

Collection of the well data and natural feature information is important for all parties involved and will help Strada to make decisions based on comprehensive data regarding the merit in applying for a below-the-water-table (Quarry) licence on an existing gravel pit on the 4th line, Melancthon.

The purpose of the **WELLness Check Program** is to confirm the existence and condition of existing water wells and natural features (i.e. wetlands, woodland, watercourse, groundwater seep, etc). Essentially securing a baseline of information about the environment before a potential quarry is considered.

We would like to remind you that the WELLness Check is provided at no cost to you. By participating in the WELLness Check:

- You allow both Strada and NDACT to better assess, understand, and minimize potential impacts to existing water wells and natural features.
- If an issue arises in the future, Participating Landowners will have documented baseline conditions.
- If there are future water disruptions to your well(s) and/or on-site features, participating landowners will be able to participate in a complaint procedure formalized between Strada and NDACT. The complaint procedure was developed to ensure complaints are handled efficiently and effectively. This procedure is included as part of Schedule C (Wells and Natural Features) in the Strada-NDACT agreement. This agreement is available for download on both Strada's and NDACT's websites.

With this letter, we have included the necessary next steps and associated forms for obtaining a WELLness Check. Please take the time to read the documents and follow all instructions. Should you require more forms, we have posted them on our websites:

STEPS FOR COMPLETING THE WELLNESS CHECK

<u>Step One</u>: Select a Certified Well Inspector and Make a WELLness Appointment

Please select one of the **Certified Well Inspectors** listed below:

- Stan Wright & Co. Well Drillers,
- Hanlon Well Drilling,
- Keith Lang Water Well Drilling Inc.

Next, call or email Strada's **WELLness Administrator** who will provide a block of availability dates and times for the selected Certified Well Inspector to come visit your property. You can select a preferred date and time, and Strada will coordinate the appointment with the Certified Well Inspector and confirm the appointment with you via email.

If you need to change or cancel the appointment, please contact Strada's **WELLness Administrator**.

<u>Step Two</u>: Complete the WELLness Forms to the best of your ability.

This WELLness Package includes two forms:

- Water Well Checklist: to be completed for each water well on your property.
- Natural Features Checklist: to be completed for all natural features on your property.

Please complete both forms to the best of your knowledge <u>prior to your scheduled</u> <u>appointment</u>.

The Certified Well Inspector will be able to help verify the details and finalize the **Water Well Checklist** on the day of your scheduled appointment.

If you need further clarification when completing the **Natural Features Checklist**, contact Strada's **WELLness Administrator**. For simple queries, the WELLness Administrator can arrange for Strada's **Natural Environment Consultant**, to be available via phone/email. For more complicated queries, the WELLness Administrator will arrange for Strada's **Natural**

Environment Consultant to visit your property in the spring of 2024 to help complete the **Natural Features Checklist.**

Should you make a mistake and/or require another copy of one of the checklists, they are available for download on both the Strada and NDACT website, or simply contact Strada's **WELLness Administrator** who can arrange for additional copies to be delivered to you.

Step Three: The WELLness Appointment

One of your responsibilities to this program is to allow/grant:

- The Certified Well Inspector access to your property to further assess your well(s).
- Strada's Natural Environment Consultant, access to your property to further assess your Natural Features where required.

For their part: the **WELLness Administrator** will:

- Be your single point of contact for organizing the WELLness appointment and/or the spring 2024 natural environment visit (where required).
- Send you a reminder email one day prior to the scheduled appointment.

For their part: the **Certified Well Inspector** will:

- Confirm the details you have completed on your checklist.
- Confirm other well details including MECP water well record number, diameter, depth, groundwater level, depth, condition, etc.
- Confirm pump well details including type, size, depth of installation, age, condition, etc.
- Confirm current water treatment systems in place (this will require access to house) including type(s), condition, etc.

For their part, if they need to visit your property, the **Natural Environment Consultant** will:

- Confirm the details you have completed.
- Complete any missing information on the Natural Features Checklist.

At the end of the appointment, please provide your completed **Water Well Checklist** and **Natural Features Checklist** to the **Certified Well Inspector** who will deliver them to Strada.

Step Four: Next Steps

The Certified Well Inspector will provide Strada with your completed Water Well Checklist and Natural Features Checklist.

Strada will update their database with your WELLness information.

Strada will mail you a copy of all completed forms for your records.

Strada will keep you informed of any future on-property appointments that may be required to fulfil the monitoring requirements of the Program.
